Our MTCs are customized to ensure that all Advanced Life Support and Basic Life Support equipment can be properly stored and safely transported. The MTCs are equipped with certified rollover protection that meets the regulations and guidelines of the Canadian Department of Transportation.

Configuring Services for Each Client

Medcor Canada collaborates with each client to determine the optimal mix of services to meet their needs and budget. Clients select the scope of services, clinical staff levels and hours of operation, up to 24/7 coverage.

On-Site Medical Trailers

At temporary locations, we also offer our custom mobile medical trailers. These trailers allow for enhanced treatment and assessment of patients. Each trailer has a ramp door for stretcher access and an examination table for proper assessment of injuries. The trailers allow for treatment of multiple patients at one time. They have abundant lighting and appropriate space to perform advanced procedures, such as suturing, which requires a sterile field in order to be done successfully.
